Immanuel Schools, a tax exempt organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, is conducting a Truck Raffle pursuant to California Penal Code Section 320.5, et seq,. The Rules and Regulations of the Raffle are set forth below. By purchasing a Raffle ticket the purchaser agrees to be bound by these rules and regulations. Immanuel Schools interpretation and application of these rules and regulations shall be final.

Only 1000 tickets will be sold and the winner will be determined by random drawing. The chances of winning are based on the number of tickets sold. The Internal Revenue Service (IRS) has taken the position that amounts paid for chances in raffles, lotteries or similar drawings for valuable prizes are not gifts, and consequently do not qualify as deductible charitable contributions.

By entering this raffle, each participant releases Immanuel Schools, its directors, officers, employees and agents from any and all liability for injuries, losses or damages of any kind caused by participating in the raffle or winning the prize or acceptance, possession, use or misuse of the prize and agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Immanuel Schools from any and all losses, damages, rights, claims and actions of any kind rising in connection with or as a result of participating in the raffle or the winner's acceptance or use of the prize.

Tickets are \$100 each, or six (6) tickets for \$500, or twelve (12) tickets for \$1000. Only one method of payment, one name and one mailing address are permitted per ticket. Only one eligible person may be entered in the raffle per ticket sold. Immanuel Schools reserves the right to reject any ticket entry that is submitted with payment that does not constitute "good funds". Prior to the prize drawing, Immanuel Schools will make a reasonable effort to notify the individual that submits such an entry, which has been rejected because the credit card or check did not clear, that the entry has been rejected by attempting to make contact through the information provided on the ticket. Immanuel Schools assumes no responsibility for lost, late, misdirected or non-delivered mail or any other failure to receive or deliver ticket entries prior to the drawing. An individual may purchase as many Raffle tickets as he or she may wish, subject to availability.

Tickets cannot be purchased on the website or by email. Any ticket entry attempted or requested by email will be rejected. All ticket entries must include payment by cash, check or credit card. No refunds will be made except under the following circumstances; any ticket order with payment received after 1,000 tickets have been sold. No other refunds are available except at the exclusive discretion of Immanuel Schools.

Anyone 18 years of age or older at the time of purchase may enter. Immanuel Schools and Marten's Chevrolet employees and their immediate families are excluded. All federal, state and local laws and regulations apply. This raffle is void where prohibited or restricted by law. The prize is not redeemable for cash or exchangeable in any way for anything else. Immanuel Schools shall assume the sales tax, vehicle registration fees and first year license fees. The drawing will be held once all 1,000 tickets are sold.

Winner need not be present to win. The winner will be notified according to the contact information provided on the ticket. The winner has 30 days from the time of the drawing to claim the prize. Should the winner not claim their prize within 30 days of the drawing, such winner will be deemed to have elected to forfeit their winnings and another drawing for a new winner will commence. In order to collect his or her prize the winner may be required to (1) sign a sworn affidavit of eligibility in accordance with these rules and applicable state and federal laws, including without limitation that he or she is at least 18 years old at the time he or she purchased the winning raffle ticket; (2) such written information as is required by any applicable tax laws including without limitation his or her Social Security Number; (3) proof of identity in forms satisfactory to Immanuel Schools showing that the person claiming the prize is the same person who is named on the winning raffle ticket; and (4) the winning raffle ticket stub. The Prize winner may be required to submit a W2G, form 5754 or similar tax form (provided by Immanuel Schools) for IRS tax withholding purposes.
